Popup Blockers and VKViewer / webVIEW

When you print a report from VKViewer/webVIEW, it pops up in a new window. Many browsers' either have a built-in popup blocker OR are using a 3rd party tool-bar (like Google's or Yahoo's) that will block popups. Generally, a popup is used by a site to promote a product or advertise and thus, is rightly blocked. We generate our reports in a popup and it's most likely you'd want to see it. Every popup blocker can be turned off OR told to allow popups from a specific site. We strongly suggest you do the latter, allow popups from the site where you're viewing the repair data.

The below is how it's done in IE on XP SP2. It will be similar on all systems.
